


## Project Information

## **Project: St Michael's Fulham**

St Michael's Centre Fulham was originally built as church, but has been used as a youth club for the past 50 years. Their goal is to equip people with skills for life within a positive and nurturing community. They achieve this by running several enjoyable activities, some educational, some for health and fitness but most activities are there just for young people to build positive relationships, have fun and enjoy themselves. The centre focuses on the self-worth of the young people and their future role that they will play in the community; they remind them of their potential and opportunities.

The St Michael's Centre is committed to the safety and wellbeing of young people and families in Sand's End and surrounding areas. They run activities for Primary School children and their families, a youth club, sports activities including football, archery, karate classes and more.

The centre is firmly established in the community, their facilities and décor are in need of being brought up to date. Habitat for Humanity GB Homes are working with them on an exciting long term plan to include affordable housing, but in the meantime, we are delighted to offer the opportunity for volunteers and corporates to partner with us to help improve and decorate the venue to be more attractive and welcoming.

### **Current Tasks**

The tasks available include; building storage for the art room, internal and external painting and decorating, build planters for BBQ area, create storage for bin area, repair lean to roof.

### **Volunteer Requirements**

Our volunteers come from all backgrounds and walks of life. No previous experience is necessary, just time and enthusiasm.

### **Health and Safety**

We pay the highest attention possible to health and safety and have an excellent record to date. We have full risk assessments and insurances in place and each volunteer has a health and safety induction before coming on site. ### **Directions**

Imperial Wharf Station is a 5-minute walk away. Wandsworth Town station is a 10-minute walk to the Centre. Clapham Junction is a 5-10-minute bus ride to the Centre, but trains also go from there to Imperial Wharf station.

### **Schedule**

The day starts at 8:45am on site. Volunteers will be met by the supervisor/s and given an induction to the project as well as get kitted out with protective clothing as necessary.

Refreshments will be made available throughout the day and lunch is provided. A vegetarian option is always available but any additional specific dietary requirements need to be advised in advance.

The day will finish by 4.00pm at the latest.

### **Volunteer Registration Form**

All volunteers coming on site need to complete our Volunteer Registration Form in advance and bring it with them on the day. The form includes a section for medical conditions to be listed, however we do ask as far as possible to be made aware of any particular requirements in advance so we can adjust the day accordingly.

### **What to wear**

Habitat for Humanity provide all safety gear necessary, including hard hats, gloves, high-vis vests and boots. All volunteers should wear old clothes, socks and shoes that they don't mind getting dirty and long trousers (no skirts). Volunteers will be outside for part of the day, so please dress accordingly.

### **Costs**

Although we are extremely grateful for volunteers' time, this particular project is self-funded and we therefore ask for £100 per person, per day. As well as a donation amount, this includes lunch and refreshments throughout the day, cost of full supervision and training required, all required PPE, risk assessments and insurance as well as materials and equipment.
